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Notes for the guidance of applicants

The Thomas Rawlins Foundation is administered by a body of Trustees who, at their absolute discretion, can make grants from the funds available to assist young persons to pursue their education.

The young person must be resident in the parish of Quorndon, Woodhouse, Woodhouse Eaves or Barrow-upon-Soar; those of the first three parishes being given preference.

Assistance may be given for the following purposes:

- 1. The award of Scholarships, Bursaries or Maintenance Allowances tenable at any school, university, college or other place of learning approved by the Trustees
- 2. The provision of financial assistance towards outfits, clothing, tools, instruments or books to enable beneficiaries on leaving school, university or any other educational establishment, to prepare for and assist their entry into work
- 3. The award of Scholarships or maintenance allowances to enable beneficiaries to travel abroad to pursue their education
- 4. The provision or assistance towards the provision, of facilities of any kind not normally provided by the Local Education Authority for recreation and social and physical training, including the provision of coaching in athletics, sports and games, for beneficiaries who are receiving primary, secondary or further education
- 5. The provision of financial assistance to enable beneficiaries to study music and other arts

It is the endeavour of the Trustees to make grants where there is the greater need, for which reason information on the parents' or guardians' resources are enquired into.
